Invitation to Participants

Education For Eternity Foundation invites graduating high school seniors and enrolled college students living in Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties to apply for a scholarship grant/award. Education For Eternity Foundation is a supporting ministry for the Seventh-day Adventist church and its mission.

The award will be in an amount of up to \$4,000. The deadline for application is by 7pm on March 31st.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a graduating high school senior or
2. Freshman, sophomore, junior or senior currently enrolled in an Adventist college or university.
3. Maintain at least 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
4. Conduct at least 30 hours of community service.
5. Provide at least 2 letters of recommendation from teachers, pastors and/or religious leader.
6. Submission of a 2-3 page , typed essay, font sized 12, Times New Roman font, 1 inch margin, on any of the following topics : (a) My Adventist Christian Education Journey (b) Discuss why you are a good candidate for this grant/award.
7. Be accepted for admission at an accredited Seventh-day Adventist institution of higher learning that leads to a degree.
8. Provide a copy of the acceptance letter or certification of enrollment issued from an Adventist two or four year college or university.

Deadline for Submission

Entries must be submitted by 7pm on March 31st and shall be accompanied by the completed Profile for Financial Grant located on the EFEF website. Please e-mail your entry application to: MyEFEF@gmail.com

A panel of judges and a committee will choose awardees based on essay, community involvement, recommendations, financial profile and availability of foundation resources.
